ENTRIES OPEN March 13, 2025 AT 6PM PST and CLOSE April 1, 2025 AT 6PM PST or earlier if limit is reached.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED before the close TO CONSIDER YOUR ENTRY COMPLETE – ONLINE Entry through DOGSHOW.CA. WAITLIST will be started.

Entries will be limited to the number of dogs able to run during daylight hours.

“DAY OF” ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED PROVIDING LIMIT HAS NOT BEEN REACHED.



The BC All Breed Pointer Club will conduct 2 licensed CKC Water Dog Junior Tests for all pointing breeds at Jura Stock Ranch, Princeton, BC on April 12 & 13, 2025.

The Tests are held under the CKC pointing breeds Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2024. CKC, 5397 Eglinton Avenue W Suite 101 Etobicoke, ON M9C 5K6.

ENTRIES: Entries will open at 6:00 pm PST Thursday March 13, 2025 and close at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday April 1, 2025 at 6PM PST. Draw will follow immediately after closing at Nanaimo, BC. Entries to be submitted on-line through www.DogShow.ca. For those who choose not to enter online, the entry must be sent to Event Secretary at bcallbreedpointerclub@gmail.com. Payment in full must accompany all entries. Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run during daylight hours and a wait list will be established as tests fill.

COURSES & BIRDS: Pigeon or chukar will be used.

IMPORTANT CKC Info- TCN Number: A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) has been established by The Canadian Kennel Club and **MUST ACCOMPANY** the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration

number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. An additional fee of \$10.50 (incl GST) per dog per event entered during the field test is required in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC will not award a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit www.CKC.ca to obtain a TCN.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT: Volunteers are essential to run a Water Test!

New participants will be shown the ropes and there will be a sign up sheet shared after your confirmed entry. Please head to the saloon when you arrive to confirm your volunteer position.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All participants must abide by the direction of the Event Chair while at the event.
- The BCABPC wishes to remind all participants and spectators that there will be no **exercising or training** of any dogs on the grounds before, during or after the test without the permission of the Water Test Chairman and Water Test Secretary.
- The BCABPC reserves the right to **limit entries** to the available daylight hours and, if necessary, to rearrange the running order.
- Day of test entries will be accepted if the schedule allows. Such entries must be presented to the Test Secretary no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time for the test along with a \$20 additional fee.
- The duty of having a dog ready in place when required for judging rests solely with its handler or owner. If a dog is not present at the place where it is to start within 5 minutes after it is called for by the judges to run, it must be disqualified. The judges are responsible for keeping the

time.

- No dog shall be picked up during a test except with permission from the judge.
- **All participants** must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. *CKC Field & Water Dog Tests Rules & Regulations for Pointing Breeds (Effective January 1, 2023)* are available from the CKC or online at the CKC website.

- Chewing or eating a bird at any time during a Test will result in automatic failure at any Field Dog Test level. (11.7)
- Bitches in season may run at the end of the day. Entrants with a bitch in season must notify the Test Secretary prior to the start of the Test they are entered in, that their bitch is in season.
- Collaring is permitted only as allowed with the permission of the judge as in the *CKC Field Dog & Water Tests Rules & Regulations for Pointing Breeds (Effective January 1, 2023)*.
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic collars that are designed for *tracking only* may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Test Chairman. Collars must be approved by the judges before a dog commences running a test.
- GALLERY (audience) viewing is at the discretion of the judge. The gallery must remain quiet and 50 feet behind the Judges and Handlers and must not interfere with the Judges and Handlers or dog(s).
- The BCABPC is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the BCABPC. Any such claims will be reviewed by the Board. If a claim of harassment or discrimination is determined, disciplinary measures will be applied, up to and including

termination of membership, or suspension from participation in future events for a length of time as determined by the Board.

- Participants must check in with the event secretary at the saloon prior to running their dog.

CKC Chapter 16: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Water Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

LIABILITY: All entries for this Water Test are accepted on condition that the BCABPC, its officials and members, landowners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Water Dog Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

DIRECTIONS TO JURA STOCK RANCH

Princeton/Summerland Road, Princeton, BC

Take Highway #3 into Princeton (from either east or west) and turn towards town onto Bridge Street (Petro-Canada station on the corner). Immediately turn right onto Highway #5A. Take Highway #5A over the steel bridge and just around the curve up the hill, turn right on Old Hedley Road.

If coming across the US border in western Washington, take the Sumas/Huntington crossing. This crossing will take you directly to Highway #1 eastbound. Once you get to Hope (about 1 to 1 ½ hours) you will see the sign for Highway #3 which goes off to the right.

If you are coming into Princeton from Highway #5A north (Merritt, etc.) stay on it until there is a turn to the left just as you come over the hill into town (a marker is the road sign warning of a change to speed of 70 km/hr.). Turn left onto Old Hedley Road.

From Old Hedley Road, quite quickly you will turn left onto the Princeton/Summerland Road (also known as Osprey Lake Road). Drive past the fair grounds and stay on that same road for approximately 7 km. You will pass Belfort Road on your left and then the road bends to the right. You will see a sign on your right for Jura Stock Ranch/Maverick Saloon. Turn right into the driveway and you are there!
